SUBJECT: Angulated Fractures of Long Bones

Special attention should be paid to the following statements of policy in dealing with angulated fractures of long bones.

Maryland EMT's will be trained and tested on the treatment of angulated fractures as follows:

- Fractures should be straightened prior to splinting; this policy applies to both open and closed fractures.
- Information contained in Emergency Care, Second Edition, Page 324, titled "Remember", should be discounted.

This policy variation should be called to the attention of all EMT Personnel in Maryland.

Special attention should be paid to the following state-
ments of policy in dealing with analyzed traces of long
range.

Traces will be examined and tested on the treat-
ment of analyzed traces as follows.

- Traces should be stratified prior to analyzing.
This policy applies to both open and closed
traces.

- Information contained in Emergency Case, Second
Edition, Page 3.4, titled "Remember", should be
discarded.
